Important dates with regard to registering and deregistering for EXAMS

REGISTRATION AND DEREGISTRATION PERIODS

1.1 DEREGISTRATION PERIOD

In accordance with article 1.3 of the examination regulations a student who is enrolled for a programme component shall deregister electronically in 'My academic file' if he does not want to sit a normally planned examination. This article is strictly adhered to.

The deregistration periods are:

- first semester: Mo 12.12.2011 through Fri 23.12.2011
- second semester: Mo 21.05.2012 through Fri 01.06.2012

After this period non-attendance for an exam should be legalized (medical certificate, ...) if one wants to enrol for a repeat exam. In case of doubt students should contact the ombuds person.

1.2 REGISTRATION FOR SECOND EXAMINATION OPPORTUNITY (REPEAT EXAMS)

In accordance with article 1.3 of the examination regulations a student who has failed to utilise his first examination opportunity, shall be able to utilise his first examination opportunity during the next exam period. When a student wishes to utilise this opportunity, he shall register electronically for the examination in question in 'My Academic file'. This article is strictly adhered to.

The registration period for the second semester is :

Mo 21.05.2012 through Fri 01.06.2012.

1.3 EXAMINATION OPPORTUNITY IN JANUARY/FEBRUARY: REGISTRATION PERIOD

Last-year students have the possibility to graduate in January/February. Article 1.3, part 8 of the examination regulations stipulates: In exceptional cases an extra deliberation may be organized in January/February for students who are able to complete their programme at that time. Students who wish to do so need to submit a formal request with the chairman of the Examination Board before 15 October. The decision of the Examination Board is communicated to the student in question by 1 November at the latest. If necessary and after consulting the coordinating lecturer, examinations can also be organised for programme components that have not been evaluated regularly in the previous examination period(s); however, students need to enrol for such examinations.

REGISTRATION PERIOD 2ND EXAMINATION OPPORTUNITY

In accordance with article 1.3 of the examination regulations a student can only take their 2nd examination opportunity in the last exam period (September). A student who wishes to utilise this opportunity can register and deregister electronically from 11.07.2012 through 11.08.2012.

DEREGISTRATION FOR PROGRAMME COMPONENTS (LEARNING CREDIT)

In accordance with article 6.3 of the education regulations a student can ask the examination board to amend the number of chosen credits (study contract). The modification will be incorporated in the student's individual learning credit. An application form for a request can be downloaded (My academic file). The duly completed application form must be submitted to the student administration.

Deregistration for programme components is possible until one day before the start of the exam period in which the programme component is evaluated (first examination opportunity). For SEMESTER 1 programme components, this can be done up to and including 08.01.2012. For SEMESTER 2 programme components, this can be done up to and including 03.06.2012.

INDIVIDUALIZED PATHWAY

A student wishing to do an individualized pathway shall address a reasoned request to the student administration at the latest on Fri 30.09.2011.

INSPECTION MOMENTS EXAMINATIONS

Following the announcement of the results of an examination, each student may inspect his examination work and ask examiners questions about it (also after oral examinations).

Inspection moments are planned on Mo 09.07.2012 and Tu 10.07.2012.
