Call for posters

On 17 December 2021, the second edition of the YLRC will take place. Participation in this conference is possible both online and on campus. The aim of the YLRC is to gather young legal researchers and to give them the opportunity to explain aspects of their research and to discuss these or legal research in general with other young legal researchers from all over Europe. With the first edition, we have already started to build a network of legal PhDs from no less than 8 different countries. We want to expand this network further in the coming editions. Participating in the YLRC therefore gives you, as a young researcher, the opportunity to present your legal research to an international audience in an accessible way.

Would you like to present your legal research in a different way than by means of a powerpoint presentation, paper, ...? Translate your research into a poster! During the second edition of the YLRC, we will organise a legal poster contest.

What?

Winning is more important than participating! Each submitted poster will be put in the picture in a European network of legal researchers prior to the second edition of the YLRC. This will happen through social media and our website. During the YLRC itself, the posters will be presented to all participants. On 17 December, each participant will have the opportunity to vote for their favourite poster. At the end of the conference day, the winner of the poster contest will be announced. The winner will earn eternal YLRC fame and will receive a nice prize.

Why?

Because posters are not limited to graphics. You can tell much more than that with them! Legal research can also be captured in a graphically attractive way. However, the use of posters is not yet an established phenomenon within legal studies. The YLRC team wants to change this. In our opinion, the simple presentation of your research is a quality that legal researchers should develop.

Who?

Any legal researcher who would like to showcase their legal research in a simple and attractive way can submit a poster. Each submitter is automatically admitted as a participant of the YLRC on 17 December 2021 and can attend the conference both online or on campus.

How?

You certainly don't have to be a graphic designer. We provide a **PPT template** on the basis of which you can design a poster. You can find this template on our **website**.

We are also happy to provide a number of tips & tricks for an attractive legal poster. On our **website**, you will find a number of useful links to tutorials, guidelines, free images, etc.¹

Are you up to the challenge?

Submit your poster prepared according to the **YLRC template** before **1 December 2021** in pdf format via ylrc@uhasselt.be together with a short description of yourself and your research. This description will serve to support the poster. After all, not only making posters but also reading and interpreting them takes some practice...
