

JOSS Friday Football Rules

General information

- Free activity for students of Statistics
- Inside football during whole academic year
- Friday 16.30-18.30
- Fitlink gym
- Every Friday starting 21/09/2018 up to 14/06/2019, including any holiday and exam period
- No football on these dates: 28/12/2018 and 04/01/2019.

Participants:

- 1st year students, 2nd years students, CenStat staff
- In case there are not too many participants on regular basis, feel free to invite any friend to join (especially encouraged during exam period, where attendance is traditionally lower)

Important rules:

- No shoes with dark outsole. It damages the surface.
- No shoes that you just used outside. You are supposed to change shoes inside Fitlink. Especially crucial in winter when technical salt is everywhere outside.
- In general, special indoor shoes are recommended.
- No watch or metal jewellery during the game (indeed piece of cloth is completely fine, only stuff that can hurt anybody else is not allowed).
- No serious arguing. It is for fun.
- Who wouldn't comply with these simple rules, would be sent home.

Practical stuff:

- Be aware of lower temperatures during winter and dress appropriately.
- There is ball always available at the bar of Fitlink, but it is usually not so good. Therefore, there is ball bought by JOSS that is available for game. If present, it would be taken care of by JOSS representative, otherwise, ball will be provided to any student that plans to attend the game (there are no strict rules for this, we always manage to sort this out appropriately).
- JOSS is formally responsible for the event, since JOSS pays for the booking and deals the contract with Fitlink.
- If too many players (more than 6 vs 6), usual practise is rotation of players after one goal or after ten minutes without goal.
- Outs are kicked, not thrown.
- Before the end of the Academic Year there will be a one-day tournament between 3 teams- 1st year students, 2nd years students, CenStat staff
