<p>Nomination (compulsory)</p>	<p>Nomination Procedure 2026–2027</p> <p>Starting from the academic year 2026–2027, all nominations for incoming students will be handled via Mobility Online.</p> <p>The nomination link will be available from March onwards.</p> <p>For any questions, please contact exchange@uhasselt.be.</p> <p>Deadlines:</p> <p>First semester (Autumn semester) or full academic year: 15 May of the prior academic year</p> <p>Second semester (Spring semester): 15 October of the same academic year</p>
<p>Online registration (compulsory)</p>	<p>All incoming exchange students must first complete their pre-arrival administrative steps in Mobility Online. Once the nomination has been accepted, students will be given access to their Mobility Online workflow, where they will be asked to upload the required documents and complete the necessary pre-arrival tasks. Please note that only complete files can be processed, meaning all required documents must be uploaded.</p> <p>After these Mobility Online steps have been completed and approved, students will receive a separate email with a link to their UHasselt Student Information System (SIS) student file. Students will have 7 days to activate their SIS account after receiving this email.</p> <p>They must then complete the SIS student file with all required information and documents before the online registration deadline. Again, only complete files will be accepted.</p>

Average accommodation cost per month	<p>Average rents range from €360 (single room with common shower/bathroom) to €480 (single room with private shower/bathroom) euros per month (please make sure utility costs are not included in the rent, this is an additional cost of approximately € 90/month).</p>

Transport	<p>Hasselt University offers a cheap bike for students during their stay at Hasselt University. We only charge a 70 euro deposit that we reimburse after the return of the bike + 25 euro rent for your full stay.</p> <p>Students have to register online to obtain a bike:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go to citybike.uhasselt.be and create a login. Pls. NOTE: when your home address shows another country but Belgium, you will not have to fill in the so-called 'National Number'. • Then go to 'Rent a bicycle', fill in all the fields, and print your contract. • Read/print the 'Rent Regulations'. • Pay the 70 euro deposit + 25 euro rent via bank transfer, if possible, and bring a proof of payment.
Insurance	<p>As health insurance is mandatory in Belgium, Hasselt University insists that all students are covered with insurance for the full period of their stay. Furthermore, we strongly advise students to subscribe to some form of hospitalisation and repatriation insurance, as far as it is not included in your health insurance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>EU Students</u> are typically covered through their local insurance and EHI-card. • <u>All NON-EU Students</u> should enrol into the AON Student Insurance

	<p>at https://www.aonstudentinsurance.com/students/en/ which costs 40 EUR/month. This is a comprehensive insurance, covering civil liability, repatriation, health and accident insurance.</p> <p>After payment of the fee, you will receive a certificate that you should upload into your student file.</p> <p>Please make sure you use the exact same name and surname as for your enrolment at Hasselt University.</p> <p>If you have any further questions about insurance, please contact ms. <p>Visa/travel documents</p>	<p>A visa should be applied for at the Belgian Embassy or consulate in the home country well in advance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>EU-nationals</u> do NOT need a visa • <u>non-EU nationals residing outside the EU</u> will always need a visa ('C' < 3 months or 'D' > 3 months) • <u>non-EU nationals residing INSIDE the EU</u> and carrying a valid residence permit from that EU-country, do NOT need a visa for stays < 3 months; for stays > 3 months; always apply for a Belgian visa in your current EU-country and do NOT travel to Belgium without a valid visa. <p>Always check the website of the Federal Foreign Affairs Department to find out whether you need a visa to come to Belgium.</p>

	<p>If you need a visa, you will have to prove your solvency. This solvency can be proven in different ways:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A document certifying that the student has been awarded a study grant or scholarship • A proof of your own financial means by transferring a certain amount to a blocked bank account in Belgium on your name • An agreement for acceptance of financial responsibility (letter of a guarantee) by the so-called Annex 32 <p>In case you would like to use the second option (prove your financial means), Hasselt University can assist you and provide you with a letter of proof of solvency.
