



Registration for the Second Exam Chance after a Tolerated Fail in the First Exam Chance

1. Regulations

Education and Examination Regulations (EER), Examination Regulations, Article 12.2, paragraph 8

*If a student wishes to make use of a second exam opportunity for programme components for which he/she obtained a tolerated fail grade in the first exam opportunity, he/she must submit a written request to this effect via the student administration **no later than ten working days after the announcement that he/she has satisfied the tolerance rules**. The student will register for the second exam opportunity for the relevant programme components. The examination committee may make reasoned exceptions to the period of ten working days to the student's advantage.*
